- Able to handle multiple tasks, work independently and with others in a fast-paced office
- Willing to commit 20 to 40 hours per week in our Washington, DC headquarters

The DNC Technology Department is involved in a wide-range of programs using many different types of technology. Successful candidates will have familiarity and interest in one or more of the following areas:

- Web development in HTML, CSS, PHP, JavaScript, Ruby on Rails, or related languages
- Software Engineering using Python, Ruby, Git, Linux and related technologies
- Databases and data management using MySQL, PostgreSQL, Microsoft SQL Server or similar systems
- Quantitative analysis using R, Stata, Python, or similar tools
- Applied statistics, machine learning, or experimental research
- GIS concepts and software like PostGIS and Google Maps API
- Campaign data management and analysis relating to field campaigns, polling or fundraising
